Preface

I set down sometime in 1994 with my old zipper KJV Bible to make a record of the passages that I had marked as a young man. On July 21, 2014, I went through the Bible again and added a number of passages that I had overlooked in 1994.

I seem to recall that one of my grandmothers gave it to me. It had a zipper with a little clear glass ball containing a mustard seed. I used that Bible all through elementary school, high school, and my first year in college. I bought beautiful, genuine leather KJV Oxford Reference Bible on October 21, 1966 so the underlines and marginal notes must have been made before then. I have not marked in that Bible since.

As I reread the passages that I had marked, I thought about how studying and meditating on those passages of Holy Scripture would impact the life of a teenager. How would that life be different from a teenager who did not have such an encounter with the Word? I ended up that year preaching a sermon based on the question, “What would the life of a youth be like if **these** Scriptures were a part of his or her life.” I was able to find a picture of my brother Ronald holding our Bibles the day they were given to us.

There was an infrastructure of believers that encouraged the young people to seek the Lord in His Word. I think of my grandmothers Gladys Bailey and Mable Potter, who were examples of diligent Bible students. My first-grade teacher, Pearl Monroe, was also my Bible class teacher at Church, sharing at school and at Church her deep and abiding faith. My uncle Oscar, a Gospel Preacher, and his faithful wife, Katherine, inspired me to put God first in everything in my life. My father was an Elder in our Church as far back as I can remember. His daily example of what it means to walk with God lead me to study the Word from my youth up. In fact all my uncles and aunts encouraged me in the Gospel way.

I wrote on the flyleaf in the front of the Bible the following: “February 12, 1994. Cleaning my Radio Room (I am an Extra Class Amateur Radio Operator, NG5W). Scanned through the OT & NT. Many passages underlined! As a child – at Indiana University – Praise God for His word! As an adult (46) I am reading through his word. Signed, Don Potter. I also wrote later, on January 1, 1998, “Finding life in the Word. Lord, help me to immerse myself in Your word this year – renew my zeal. D.P.” I am now 67 years old and reading this year though my new Cambridge Paragraph King James Bible (Howard Norton edition).

May this little autobiographical sketch encourage the youth of today to seek Christ our Savior in His inspired Word. Note that these are just the verses I underlined, marked, or annotated. Of course, I read a lot that I did not mark. This is just a tiny glimpse of the full impact. I personally recommend the KJV, NJKV, or perhaps the ESV, not the NIV.

It is good to recall that Paul wrote to Timothy, “And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.” I did not mark this verse, but I did mark the next one. I am blessed that my parents obeyed Paul’s admonition in Ephesians 6:4 to “bring them up in the nurture and admotion of the Lord.”

7. Numbers 21:14 – ...the book of the wars of the LORD....

8. Numbers 22:1 – this side of Jordan by Jericho... (I wrote in margin Name of Place)

9. Numbers 33:2 – Moses wrote their goings out...

10. Deuteronomy 31:24 – And I came to pass, when Moses had made an end of writing the words of this law in a book, until they were finished.

11. Deuteronomy 34:5 – So Moses the servant of the LORD died there in the land of Moab, according to the word of the LORD.

12. 2 Kings 17:23 – Until the LORD removed Israel out of his sight, as he had said by all his servants the prophets. So was Israel carried away out of their own land to Assyria unto this day. (I wrote in the margin 10 lost tribes)

13. 2 Chronicles 27:4 – Moreover he built cities in the mountains of Judah, and in the forests he built castles and towers. (I have not idea why I thought this was important.)

14. Psalms 103:12 – As far as the east is from the west so far hath he removed or transgressions from us.

15. Proverbs 18:10 – The name of the LORD is a strong tower: the righteous runneth into it, and is safe. (In the margin I wrote Jehovah and put a line to LORD.)

16. Proverbs 27:5 – Open rebuke is better than secret love.

17. Ecclesiastes 3:4 – A time to weep, and a time to laugh; a time to mourn, and a time to dance.

18. Isaiah 6:8 – Then said I, Here am I; send me.

19. Isaiah 53: The chapter heading is underlined, indicating that the whole chapter was read and was considered important.

9. Jeremiah 17:7 – Blessed is the man that trustiest in the LORD, and whose hope the LORD is.

20. Joel 2:28 –

21: Micah 6:8 He hath shown thee, O man, with is good; and what doth the LORD require of thee, but to do justly, and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with thy God.

22. Micah 6: 13 Therefore also will I make the sick and smiting thee, in making thee desolate because of thy sins.

I pray with all my heart and soul that the young people of today, especially my children and grandchildren, will follow the Word of God all their lives and experience God's love, forgiveness, grace, mercy and power.
