I am using the *Phonics Lessons* to help students coming from the other schools to the *Odessa Christian School* where I teach Spanish and remedial reading. Many of the children are unable to do the challenging A Beka Book curriculum from *Pensacola Christian College* because they lack the necessary reading skills. Mrs. Brown's phonics reading program quickly gets them "up to speed" in their reading and spelling.

I, also, use the *Phonics Lessons* with teens and adults with reading difficulties. The students have made **dramatic gains** in their reading levels regardless of age. By Lesson 22, the students will have mastered all the phonics necessary to read Paul's Epistle to the Romans in the KJV, which is considered about a 12th grade level.

The *Phonics Lessons* would be perfect for teaching ALL the functional illiterates in America to read. I can envision untold thousands of school dropouts returning to get their diplomas or GEDs.
